




UEFA defines safeguarding as:

"The organisation's responsibility to ensure that football is a safe, positive and enjoyable experience for children and that all children are kept safe from harm (including abuse) when involved in football, in all capacities and at all levels".

- Awareness-raising or training sessions with staff and coaches (MOL1 & MOL2, SWE, ROM, ARM, RUS, UKR)
- Development of referral flowchart (SWE)
- Translation and/or adaptation of online modules and educational packages (BEL, ROM, POL, RUS, ALB)

5 Goals of the Safeguarding Toolkit

Aim to support associations and clubs to achieve 5 goals of the UEFA Child Safeguarding Policy:

- Goal 1 Laying the foundations for safeguarding
- Goal 2 Ensuring organisational preparedness and prevention
- Goal 3 Raising awareness
- Goal 4 Working with others and reporting concerns
- Goal 5 Measuring success in safeguarding



The UEFA Safeguarding Toolkit





- Developed in consultation with UEFA including NAs, coaches etc.
- Focus on football and children (e.g. under 18s)
- Links with other safeguarding materials developed e.g. elearning
- Aims to be practical and reasonable
- Contains guidance and templates that can be adapted flexible
- Complimentary Does not replace existing national guidance issued by Government or other football governing body

Role of Child & Youth Protection Officer

Acting as the first point of contact and taking the lead on child safeguarding within the organisation;

Ensuring that football programmes, practices and activities take constant and regular account of safeguarding measures.

- Ensuring safeguarding training;
- Ensuring staff and others are aware of the child safeguarding policy and their responsibilities including advise on implementation;
- Carrying out / support risk assessments;
- Mapping out / establishing partnerships so that information is available if an incident occurs or advice is needed;
- Acting as the first point of contact if incidents of abuse arise, and escalating concerns to management and local authorities, including law enforcement, as appropriate;
- Keeping an accurate record of any incidents;
- Maintaining the safeguarding implementation plan and producing an annual progress report, as requested;
- Participating in child safeguarding training, as required.


